PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.100 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The respondent police registered a case as against this petitioner in Crime No.100 of 2024 for the offence under Sections 294(B), 353, 307 and 506(ii) of IPC, Section 4(a) of Explosive Substances Act and Section 25(1A) of Arms Act and remanded him into judicial custody on 10.05.2024.

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2.The case of the prosecution is that on 03.05.2024, when the defacto complainant and his assistant were on patrol duty, the petitioner along with other accused abused the defacto complainant in filthy language, tried to attack them with aruval and country bomb and also threatened them with dire consequences. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent and his name was not found in the FIR. He further submits that he is languishing in jail for the past 32 days.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent has raised serious objections and submits that on 03.05.2024, when the defacto complainant and his assistant were on patrol duty, the petitioner along with other accused abused the defacto complainant in filthy language, tried to attack them with aruval and country bomb and also threatened them with dire consequences.

5.Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on the following conditions:-

i) The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the



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learned Judicial Magistrate, Periyakulam, Theni;

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ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;

iii) The petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;

iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.

v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the bail.
