No.1351 of 2023 dated 02.03.2023 on the file of the Sub-Registrar, Aruppukottai, Virudhunagar in the light of the enquiry report filed by the 3rd respondent dated 10.11.2022 and as well as the petitioner's representation dated 20.09.2023 submitted to the first respondent in person within the time limit that may be stipulated by this Court.
