PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.236 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 8(c) and 20(b)(ii)(B) NDPS Act, in Cr.No.236 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.



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2.The case of the prosecution is that A1 and A2 were found in illegal possession of 1100 grams of ganja.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has realised his mistake and in order to show his bonafide, he has deposited a sum of Rs.25,000/- in favour of the "Chief Educational Officer, Tirunelveli" for the welfare of the Government School students.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) for the respondent submits that the petitioner is having one previous case pending as against him.

5.Though the petitioner is having one previous case, considering this change in the attitude of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this criminal original petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for NDPS Cases, Madurai on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District and Sessions Judge, Special Court for NDPS Cases, Madurai and on further conditions that:



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- i. The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;
- ii. The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required. He has to co-operate for the investigation.
- iii. The petitioner shall file an affidavit of undertaking before the respondent police that he will not indulge in any offence in future.
- iv. The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. The petitioner shall be available for the trial as well.
- v. On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
