ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondents 1 to 3 to take action, on the basis of the representation submitted by the petitioner's wife dated 16.06.2022, within the time stipulated by this Court.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that one Karunakaran, the Sub-Inspector of Police, called the petitioner through cell phone to attend enquiry before the fourth respondent Police about his loan issue with one Arul Murugan, and thereafter, the petitioner has also appeared before the fourth respondent, however, the fourth



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wife is having any grievance, she has to file a private complaint under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C or 200 Cr.P.C, as against the erring officials, instead, the petitioner's wife has made the representation before the respondents Police which is not sustainable one.

5. Recording the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents, this Writ Petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a private complaint under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C or Section 200 Cr.P.C. There shall be no order as to costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
