Prayer in CRL.A(MD) No.328 of 2024:

Criminal Appeal filed under section 14 A (2) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 as amended by Act 1/2016, to call for the entire records relating to the order dated 03.04.2024 made in Cr.M.P.No.781 of 2024 on the file of the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989, Sivagangai and to set aside the same as arbitrary and consequently to release the appellant on bail in connection with the FIR in Crime No.61 of 2024 on the file of the 2nd respondent Police.
