2.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner's sale deed bearing Document No.4956 of 2013 was misplaced, thereby, he made a complaint before the second respondent police to issue non-treaceable certificate and the same was not considered. Hence, the petitioner has filed the present petition with the above said prayer.

3.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that for issuance of Non Treaceable Certificate, the Director General of Police issued a circular on 01.04.2022 and as per the circular, the petitioner's application will be considered and appropriate orders will be passed.
