PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS / 438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.195 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in connection with a case in Crime No.195 of 2024, for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506 (ii) IPC, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to some dispute, the petitioner along with other accused abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and also attacked him with a knife and caused injury. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the earlier application was dismissed considering the antecedent of the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has no previous case pending against him.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent Police submits that the previous cases are as against the co-accused and not against the petitioner and it has been falsely represented before this Court.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the

antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

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6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of his arrest or on his appearance within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Illayangudi, on condition that

(i) the petitioner execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Illayangudi.

(ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the government in proof of their residence address;

(iii) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. He has to co-operate for the investigation.

(iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
