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Prayer in CRL A(MD). 241 of 2024 :

Criminal Appeal filed under Section 14 A (2) of SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 as amended by Act 1 of 2016, to call for the records relating to the order of dismissal of bail application dated 02.03.2024 made in Crl.M.P.No.330 of 2024 on the file of the learned Sessions Judge, Special Court for Exclusive Trial of Cases under SC/ST (POA) Act, Dindigul, and set aside the same and grant bail to the appellant by allowing this Criminal Appeal.
