Prayer in WP(MD). 10834/ 2012 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records relating to the proceedings of the respondent in Oo.Mu.(AA.6) 3633/2012, dated 28.06.2012 quash the same and consequently direct the respondent to award compensation at Rs.1600/- per cent to the petitioner land to an extent of 1.36 acres S.No.15/9, Soolakari Village of Aruppukkottai Taluk with all statutory benefits as contemplated order under Land Acquisition, Act 1894 within the stipulated time to be fixed by this Honourable Court.

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Madurai (2001)] within a period of two weeks, failing which, this petition shall stand dismissed automatically without reference to this Court.
