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This Criminal Appeal is filed under section 14(A) (2) of the Schedule Castes and Tribes Prevention of Atrocities Act, 2015 (Amended by Act 1 of 2016), to call for the records pertaining to the order passed in Crl.M.P.No,2176 of 2023 on the file of the Special court for Trial Cases under SC/ST (POA) Act, Sivagangai dated 02.12.2023 and set aside the same as illegal and enlarge the appellant accused on bail in connection with the case in Crime No.172 of 2023 on the file of the second respondent Police.
