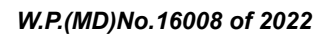

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the 2nd respondent herein not to interfere into the civil dispute, which is pending between petitioner and the 3rd respondent herein in O.S.No.258 of 2021 on the file of learned Principle District Munsif Court, Dindigul under the guise of enquiry.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is the husband of the third respondent and there is misunderstanding between them. In such circumstances, without knowledge of the petitioner, the third respondent tried to alienate the property, which was purchased by the petitioner in the name of the third respondent. Further, the petitioner filed a suit in O.S.No.258 of 2021 before the Principal District Munsif Court, Dindigul and the same is still pending and for the same dispute, the
