ORDER

This petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the first respondent to transfer the investigation in Crime No.899 of 2022 on the file of the third respondent and entrust the same to any other Police Official other than the third respondent to complete the investigation in accordance with law within the time stipulated by this Court.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel arose between the petitioner and the accused persons, the accused persons attacked the petitioner. Thereby, the petitioner preferred a case against the accused persons before the respondent Police and the respondent Police registered a case in Crime No.899 of 2022 for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 355 and 427 IPC.

In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands disposed of with a direction to the third respondent Police to complete the investigation in Crime Nos.898 and 899 of 2022 and file a charge sheet before the concerned Court within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
