PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec. 483 of B.N.S.S

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.62/2024 on the file of the respondent police



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The respondent police registered a case as against this petitioner in Crime No.62 of 2024 for the offence under Sections 307 and 448 IPC, and remanded him into judicial custody on 17.05.2024. Therefore, the petitioner has filed this petition seeking bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity, the accused have assaulted the defacto complainant's son using aruval and caused injuries. Hence the case.

3. When the earlier application was taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner was detained under the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982 and therefore, that petition was dismissed.

4. Today, the learned Counsel appearing on either side submit that now the detention order has been revoked and the petitioner is languishing in jail from 17.05.2024.

5. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent

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opposed for grant of bail on the ground that the petitioner is having two previous cases, out of which, one case is relating to a murder case and another one relates to 307 IPC offence.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the period of incarceration and also considering the fact the detention order has been revoked, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail

i) on the petitioner executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tirunelveli.

ii) The petitioner and the sureties shall submit a copy of their Aadhaar Card or any other identity card issued by the Government in proof of their residence address;

iii) The petitioner appear before the respondent Police, daily at 10.30 a.m. and 05.00 p.m until further orders and thereafter shall appear as and when required by the respondent police. He has to co-operate for the investigation.

iv) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in



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any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses. He shall be available for the trial as well.

v) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the bail.
