PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.129/2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 294(b), 323, 387, 307 and



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506(ii) IPC in Cr.No.129 of 2024, seeks anticipatory bail.

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2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein and other accused have waylaid the defacto complainant's two wheeler and wordy quarrel with him and also attacked him with Aruval and also abused him in filthy language. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that the name of the petitioner is not found in FIR and prays for granting anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the damage caused is worth about Rs.27,000/- and the injured was treated as out-patient. He would further submit that the petitioner herein is having one previous case and prays for dismissal of this petition.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also considering the fact that the injured treated as out-patient, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Srivaikundam,



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Thoothukudi, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the Inspector of Police, Town police Station, Turicorin daily at 10.30 am until further orders.

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



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(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under
Section 229-A IPC.
