When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the State would submit that the petitioner had taken the lease of the land belonging to the Sri Kanchi Kodi Peedathipathi and subsequently, the petitioner has surrendered the lease hold properties and now by alleging that he is having issues with his wife, has lodged a complaint seeking police protection. He would further submit that on the basis of the compliant given by the petitioner, CSR.No.571 of 2024 came to be registered and after enquiry, the police directed the parties to approach the competent Civil Court and closed the compliant.
