COMMON ORDER

These contempt petitions have been filed that the common order of this Court in a batch of writ petitions in WP(MD) Nos.8585 of 2019 etc., dated 25.04.2019 has not been complied with.

2.Today(22.11.2024), when these contempt petitions are taken up for hearing, the learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the respondents submits that as against the order passed by this Court in the batch of writ petitions in WP(MD) Nos. 8585 of 2019 etc., dated 25.04.2019, the respondent Indian Medicine



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and Homeopathy Department preferred writ appeal in WA(MD)SR.No.16801 of 2021 and the same was dismissed at the SR stage itself on 09.11.2022. Challenging the same, the Department has preferred a Special Leave Petition with an application to condone the delay, before the Honourable Supreme Court in IA.No. 88650 of 2024, wherein, the Honourable Supreme Court has ordered notice.

3.Since the matter has been taken cognizance by the Honourable Supreme Court, these Contempt Petitions are closed with liberty to the petitioners to revive these petitions, based on the outcome from the Honourable Supreme Court.

4.Recording the aforesaid submission made by either side counsel, this contempt petition is closed.
