After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that even though the appeal is in SR stage, they have decided to comply with the award passed by the trial Court. They also deposited the entire award amount before the Trial Court and expressed to withdraw the appeal at SR stage. The Managing Director, State Express Transport Corporation, Madurai, has also made an endorsement to



that effect as the issue has been settled. Recording the same, C.M.P.(MD).No.10174 of 2023 in CMA(MD) No.SR47796 of 2023 is dismissed as withdrawn at the SR stage itself .
