Recording the submission made by the learned Special Government Pleader for the first respondent and recording the statement of the first respondent i.e., Inspector of Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department, Thoothukudi, this Writ Petition is disposed of by directing the first respondent, Inspector of Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department, to ensure that the subscriptions are collected from all the willing devotees including the petitioner and the members of the petitioner's community and no special honour will be conferred to any individual as was ordered by this Court in W.P.(MD)
