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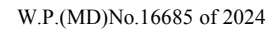

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appointment of the petitioner therein with effect from 08.03.2018. If the present petitioner claims her date of appointment relates back to the date 17.01.2018, then she can give a representation to the fourth respondent College to send a proposal to the second respondent in this regard and cause an order to be passed as requested by her on merits.

In view of the above observations, the writ petition is **disposed of** and the petitioner is at liberty to give a representation to the fourth respondent College to send a proposal to the second respondent stating that the petitioner was appointed on 17.01.2018 itself. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
