**AWARD**

Both parties along with their respective counsels are present. The appellant/Insurance company is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs.72,40,000/- and he seeks time to deposit the same.

2.The claimants/respondents 1 and 2 have agreed to receive a sum of Rs.72,40,000/- with interest and cost.

3.Considering the same, the Insurance company is directed to deposit the amount of Rs.72,40,000/- with interest and cost as awarded by the Court below, less the amount already deposited if any, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the award.

4.On such deposit being made, the respondents 1 and 2 are equally permitted to withdraw the said amount by filing necessary application before the Tribunal.
