Hence, the application made by the petitioner was rejected on 12.10.2018 and the same was communicated to the petitioner.

4. Recording the above said submission, this Writ Petition is closed. However, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the rejection order dated 12.10.2018, if he is so advised. No costs.
