ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who were arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 04.04.2024 for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 341, 323, 324, 506(2), 302 IPC and Section 3(1) of the Tamil Nadu Public Property (Prevention of Damages and Loss) Act, 1992 in Cr.No.202 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to election motive between the parties, the accused persons abused the deceased and also murdered him. Hence, the case.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners are innocents and they have been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit this Court granted bail to the co-accused and hence the petitioners may be released on bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the first petitioner is having one previous case.

5.Considering the period of incarceration and also considering the fact that this Court granted bail to the co-accused, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the

petitioners on certain conditions.

6 Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Thanjavur.

[i] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Special Court/concerned Court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[ii] The petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m, for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[iii] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

[iv] the petitioners shall not abscond during trial.

[v] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial

Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[vii] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
