This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.S.Kumar and the counsel for the second respondent Mr.C.Karthik are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



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AWARD

The learned counsel appearing for the appellants and the second respondent and their respective parties are present. After negotiation, they have agreed for settlement of Rs.9,50,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) with interest at the rate of 7.5% from the date of claim petition, in addition to the amount already awarded by the Tribunal.

2. The second respondent /Insurance Company is directed to deposit the entire amount of Rs.9,50,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only), with interest at the rate of 7.5% from the date of claim petition, in addition to the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, within a period of eight weeks from today. On such deposit, the first appellant and the fourth appellant are entitled to withdraw their respective share amounts of Rs.2,50,000/- and Rs.1,00,000/- with accrued interest respectively. The second and third appellants, who are the minors, are entitled to the amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- each. The shares of the minor appellants shall be deposited as per the procedure laid down by the Tribunal.
