PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL UNDER SECTION 482 OF BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.70/2024 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, in



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connection with a case in Crime No.70 of 2024, for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 506(ii) and 109 IPC, has filed this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous enmity, the petitioner along with other accused assaulted the defacto complainant with a wooden log. Hence, the complaint.

3.Considering the antecedent as against the petitioner, the earlier petition filed by the petitioner seeking the very same relief was dismissed on 19.07.2024.

4. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner renewed the application on the ground that out of sixteen cases registered as against the petitioner, nine cases are pertaining to Section 101 Cr.P.C proceedings.

5. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence in his previous case and he will prove his innocence. In order to show his bonafide, the Village Panchayat President one Panjavaram has given an undertaking affidavit for the petitioner stating that the petitioner will not indulge in any offence and the petitioner has also filed the same before the respondent police. Apart from the assurance, the Panchayat President has also given certificate to the petitioner that the petitioner is an innocent and she will ensure that the petitioner is not involving in any further offence. Hence, he prays for



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(iv) Mrs. T. Panjavaram, Village Panchayat President, Sirukudi Village Panchayat, shall also appear before the respondent police and file an affidavit undertaking that she will ensure that the petitioner is not involving in any further offence.

(v) The petitioner shall not misuse the liberty granted to him by indulging in any further offence and shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

(vi) On violation of any of the above conditions by the petitioner, the respondent police shall move an application for cancellation of the anticipatory bail.
