Pleased set aside the order of the Learned Judge made in WP(MD)No.9631 of 2013 dated 14.11.2022 and allow the Writ Appeal.

Prayer in WP(MD). 9631/ 2013 :

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court To issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records of the respondent in Ref. Na.Ka.(Oo.1) 10146/2012 dated 10.01.2013 and quash the same as illegal arbitrary and unenforceable consequently direct the respondent to consider the rights of petitioners on merits.
