The Criminal Appeal filed under Section 14(A)(2) of the Schedule Castes and Tribes Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989(Amended by Act 1 of 2016), to call for the records pertaining to the order passed in Crl.M.P.No.1387 of 2023 on the file of the Special Court for Trial Cases under SC/ST (POA) Act, Theni dated 09.01.2024 and set aside the same as illegal and enlarge the appellant on bail in connection with the Cr.No.464/2023 on the file of respondent police by allowing the appeal.
