The petitioners have filed this petition seeking an extension of time to pay cost as ordered by this Court on 27.02.2019.

Subsequently, the second appeal was dismissed for default on 12.03.2019 and the said dismissal order was set aside and the second appeal was restored to file by order dated 26.09.2019 on condition that the petitioners shall pay a sum of Rs.2,000/- to the Chief Justice Relief Fund. The said order was complied by the petitioners as seen from the memo filed by the learned counsel for the petitioners/appellants dated 03.10.2019.
