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The condition imposed by the order dated 13.06.2024 in Crl.M.P.(MD)No.11918 of 2022, whereby suspension of sentence was granted to the petitioner with condition that he will report before the Inspector of Police, Nagapattinam Town Police Station, Nagapattinam everyday at 10.30 a.m., is sought to be relaxed by the petitioner.

2.Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the respondent, we are of the opinion that the conditions could be relaxed. Hence, we direct the petitioner to appear before the Principal Sessions Court, Madurai once in a month, on the first working day of every English Calender month at 10.30 a.m., until the disposal of the appeal.

3.With the above modification, this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of.
