Considering the above, the fourth respondent is directed to consider the writ petitioner's representation dated 06.08.2024 by giving notice to the writ petitioner as well as to the private respondents and take a decision within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
