Thangaiyan, male, aged 34 years, who is detained in Central Prison, Tiruchirappalli before this Court and set him at liberty.

2. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents, by producing a copy of G.O.Rt.No.6552, Home, Prohibition and Excise (XV) Department, dated 19.09.2024, would state that the impugned detention order has been revoked by the Government.



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3. In view of the same, nothing survives for further adjudication.

This Habeas Corpus Petition is dismissed.
