### **ORDER**

**[Order of the Court was made by The Hon'ble ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE]**

Prayer in this writ petition is to direct the first respondent to conduct enquiry against the misappropriation made by the respondents 4 and 5 and take appropriate action against them in accordance with the Tamil Nadu Cooperative Societies Act, 1983, within the time stipulated by this Court.



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**2.** According to the petitioner, he is one of the members of MD.Thani 88 Saptur Primary Agricultural Co-operative Credit Society. The fourth respondent is the Ex-President and the fifth respondent is the Secretary of the said Society. They have involved in several misappropriations in the said Society during 2012-2018. Though the petitioner has made representations, dated 09.11.2018 and 14.11.2018, to the first respondent, the same have not been considered so far. Hence, this writ petition.

**3.** Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that it would suffice, if a direction is issued to the respondents 1 and 2 to consider the petitioner's representations dated 09.11.2018 and 14.11.2018, on merits and in accordance with law.

**4.** In view of the above submission, we direct the respondents 1 and 2 to consider the petitioner's representations, dated 09.11.2018 and 14.11.2018, pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, after providing due opportunity to the parties concerned, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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**5.** With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
