PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India,
praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the



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records relating to the impugned proceedings of the third respondent bearing P04/1/10433758/ADK/773, dated 30.01.2024 and quash the same and to restore the basic pay reduced by the respondent from Rs.59,100/- instead of Rs.57,400/- along with the monetary benefits based on the fundamental rules Rule-27 Ruling (17) and also based on the fixation & arrears given to 1995 Batchmates, by quashing the Government Letter (Ms) No.737, Home (Pol.V) Department dated 18.08.2010 communicated by the DGP, Chennai in Rc.No. 129601/NGB/III(2)/2010 dated 04.09.2010 consequently to give the arrears of pay and allowances for the post of Gr-I PC from the date of advancement of upgradation as Gr-I PC (ie.,) from 01.06.1998 instead of 28.09.1999 and the date advancement of upgradation as HC with effect from 01.06.2003 instead of 28.10.2004 as clarified by the third respondent in the Circular memorandum in C.No.81071/E/NGB.III(2)/2009, dated 02.04.2019.
