### **ORDER**

Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side, the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer, is directed to conduct peace committee meeting by calling all the groups involved and take a decision in accordance with law within three days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, this writ petition stands disposed of. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
