ORDER

It is seen from the records that originally the revision petitioner as plaintiff has filed a suit in O.S.No.1152 of 2017 before the II Additional Subordinate Court, Tiruchirappalli and subsequently the case was transferred to the newly constituted Subordinate Court at Manapparai and the same was renumbered as O.S.No.123 of 2020.

4. Recording the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the respondents, this Civil Revision Petition is dismissed as infructuous. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed. No costs.
