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ORDER

State of Gujrath)**, this Court in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to quash the proceedings in D.V.C No. 72 of 2020, on the file of the learned Additional Mahila Judge cum Judicial Magistrate, Karur.

This Criminal Original Petition stands allowed and as a sequel, the proceedings in D.V.C No. 72 of 2020, on the file of the learned Additional Mahila Judge cum Judicial Magistrate, Karur, is hereby quashed and the terms of Joint Compromise Memo shall form part and parcel of this order. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
