3.According to the petitioner, she is the owner of the land in Survey Nos.194/1, 194/2, 194/3 and 194/4 to an extent of 1.50 acres of land situated at Janagalpatti Revenue Village, Theni Taluk and District. The 3rd respondent is trying to install electricity high tension tower and also to connect electricity high tension wire through the petitioner's land without her consent. Therefore, the petitioner made a representation dated 26.07.2024 to the respondents. Since the same has not been considered so far, she has filed this Writ Petition.
