ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a Government servant seeking a Mandamus directing the respondents to reimburse the medical expenses incurred by the him for his treatment of Covid-19 in the network hospital.

The petitioner has also given representations on 15.08.2022, 02.11.2022 and 15.05.2023. However, the medical expenses have not been reimbursed. Hence, the present writ petition.
