In view of the above said statement made by the 5th respondent herein, the 5th respondent is directed to disburse the medical reimbursement amount to the petitioner, as per the directions of the State Level Empowered Committee within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of the order of State Level Empowered Committee.
