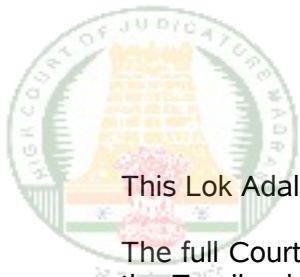
AWARD

The Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition was earlier listed in the Lok Adalat on 12.08.2023 and the parties have agreed to settle at a sum of Rs.14,00,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs only). Two installments have already been paid. Today, the respondent has paid a sum of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) to the petitioner as a final settlement.

Recording the same, this Transfer Civil Miscellaneous Petition is closed. The petitioner herein is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) in the name of the minor child in an interest bearing Fixed Deposit in any one of the nationalized Bank till she attains majority. The petitioner has handed over the Thali to the respondent. The petitioner is directed to produce the original receipt indicating the deposit made in the name of the minor.
