PRAAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus calling for the entire record pertaining to the Impugned Proceedings in ஆந் 6 / 5500 / 19 of the 1st respondent dated 11.03.2019 and to quash the same as illegal and consequently direct the 1st respondent to pay a sum of Rs.4,34,000/- (Four lakhs Thirty Four Thousand only) to the petitioner and continued to pay or refund, the entire educational expenditure / cost of my son viz., Naveenkumar (aged 6/2021) (Aadhar No.3762-0036-0796) till his graduation, by way of Government Cheque in the name of “Subbulakshmi”, within a reasonable time prescribed by this Hon'ble Court.

ORDER
