Mr.E.Antony Sahaya Prabahar, learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice for the respondents 1, 2, 5 and 6 and Mr.M.Muthumanikkam, learned Government Advocate (Civil Side) takes notice for the respondents 3 and 4. By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the writ petitioner would submit that in order to conduct temple festival from 16.09.2024 to 24.09.2024, they sought permission by giving a representation dated 29.08.2024 before the respondent police and that since no order has been passed till now, the writ petitioner was constrained to approach this Court.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1, 2, 5 and 6 would submit that the writ petitioner's representation is pending before the sixth respondent.

5. Considering the above, the sixth respondent is directed to consider the writ petitioner's representation dated 29.08.2024 and take a
