PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of B.N.S.S. U/s 439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.200/2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner/ Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 29.04.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 120B, 109, 341, 427, 294(B), 307 and 302 IPC in crime No. 200 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to business motive, the petitioner herein and other accused waylaid the deceased and committed the murder of the deceased. Hence, the case.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent and perused the materials available on record.

4. Considering the nature of allegations against the petitioner that A1 to A3 engaged the hirelings on account of previous annuity to eliminate the deceased and this petitioner being a fourth accused accompanied the hirelings and identified the deceased for them to carry out the attack and considering the fact that the petitioner is in jail from 29.04.2024 and that there are no other bad antecedents against the



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petitioner and the argument of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the
petitioner will attend all hearings in PRC No.29 of 2024 without fail and thereafter,
the sessions case, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Thanjavur.

(i)the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(ii) As per undertaken, the petitioner shall file an affidavit of undertaking to the effect that he will attend all hearing dates before the concerned Court without fail.

(iii)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

iv)the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.



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v)On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

(vi)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
