This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant, Mr. K. A. Thirumalaiappan and the counsel for the respondent, Mr. R. Maheswaran are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

**AWARD**

The Tribunal has awarded a sum of Rs.3,25,425/- with interest at 7.5% per annum. Aggrieved over the same, the Transport Corporation has preferred the present Civil Miscellaneous Appeal.



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2. Both the parties and their respective counsel are present and they arrived at an amicable settlement for a sum of Rs.3,60,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Sixty Thousand only) in full quit.

3. The Transport Corporation shall deposit the said amount before the Tribunal within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, less the amount already deposited, if any.

4. The claimant is permitted to withdraw the aforesaid amount, without filing any formal permission petition before the Tribunal.
