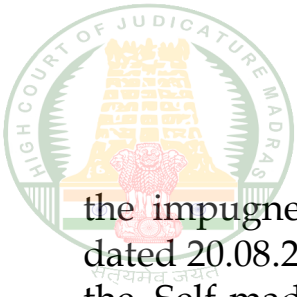

Prayer in WP(MD). No.22069 of 2024:-

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus call for the records of the impugned order passed by the 1st respondent vide Na.Ka.No.1689/E1/2024 dated 20.08.2024 and quash the same and further direct the 1st respondent to take appropriate action under Sec.46(2) of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975 for non-Compliance and contravention of the said Act.

Prayer in WP(MD). No.22209 of 2024:-

Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus call for the records of



the impugned order passed by the 1st respondent vide Na.Ka.No.1763/E1/2024 dated 20.08.2024 and quash the same and further direct the 1st respondent to declare the Self-made memorandum and bylaw of the Maria Grace Rural Educational Soecity as unlawful illegal and invalid under.7 and to take appropriate action under Sec.46(2) of the Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975.

3. Considering the request made by the Learned Principal District Judge, Madurai, time is extended further for a period of six months.

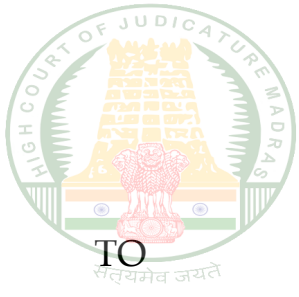
