PETITION FOR BAIL UNDER SECTION 483 OF BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.91/2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on

29.07.2024 for the offences punishable under Sections 103 of BNS, in Crime No.91 of

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2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is the brother of the deceased. The petitioner herein is none other than the wife of the deceased. The petitioner unable to bear with the behaviour of the husband/deceased, along with other accused namely, her daughters and son-in-law attacked the deceased with aruval and caused death. Hence, the complaint.

3.Heard both sides.

4.Considering the nature of the allegations that unable to bear with the behaviour of the husband, the petitioner being the wife, along with her daughters and son-in-law being other accused, attacked the deceased at home with aruval, and there were 8 cut injuries, on account of which the deceased is reported to be dead, and considering the facts that the investigation is almost over and the petitioner is in prison from 29.07.2024, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner on certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manamadurai.

(i)the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the

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surety bond and the Magistrate/concerned court may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity;

(ii)the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation;

(iii)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness;

iv)the petitioner shall not abscond during trial.

v)On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

vi)If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.
