W.P(MD)No.17491 of 2018, by order dated 10.08.2018.

3.In view of the above, the direction sought for in this
Writ Petition has become infructuous. Accordingly, the Writ Petition
is dismissed as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.
Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
