PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER:-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.258/2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/A1 to A5, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 126(2), 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) and 324(4) of BNS, in Crime No.258 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to enmity, the petitioners and other accused persons waylaid the defacto complainant's car, abused the defacto complainant and his friends in filthy language and also attacked them.

3.Heard. Perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

4.Considering the nature of allegations and that the petitioners attacked with hands and there are no bad antecedents as against the petitioners, I am inclined to enlarge the petitioners on anticipatory bail with certain conditions.

5.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate Court,

Manapārai, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent Police, daily at 06.30 p.m., for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
