ORDER

The present Writ Petition has been filed by a Special Tahsildar, seeking a Mandamus for revocation of his suspension order dated 18.04.2022.

2. The petitioner herein was placed under suspension in contemplation of an enquiry. Charge memo has been issued to the petitioner and enquiry has also been completed. However, final orders are yet to be passed by the second respondent.

3. In view of the fact that the petitioner is placed under suspension for the past 2 ½ of years, the petitioner has sent a representation to the second respondent on 10.09.2024, seeking revocation of the order of suspension. Since there is no response, the present writ petition has been filed.
