This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant Mr.I.Robert Chandrakumar and the counsel for the first respondent Mr.S.Simiyon Vergil are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



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AWARD

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The learned counsel appearing for the appellant and the first respondent and their respective parties are present. After negotiation, they have agreed for settlement of Rs. 10,10,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs and ten thousand only). Hence, the decretal amount awarded in MCOP.No.163/2021, dated 05.01.2023 on the file of the Motor Vehicles Accident Claims Tribunal, Special Sub Court, Thanjavur, is reduced to Rs.10,10,000/- (Rupees ten lakhs and ten thousand only).

2. The appellant /Insurance Company is directed to deposit the amount as per the modified decree, less the amount already deposited within a period of eight weeks from today. On such deposit, the respondents are at liberty to withdraw the entire amount as per the apportionment of the Tribunal. Except the above modification, there is no other change in the decree in MCOP.No.163/2021, dated 05.01.2023 on the file of the Motor Vehicles Accident Claims Tribunal, Special Sub Court, Thanjavur.
