Memo dated 09.01.2024 in USR.N.1269 is recorded to the effect that issuance of notice to 4th respondent is dispensed with as he was set ex-parte before the Tribunal vide Court order, dated 23.01.2024 made in CMA(MD)(No.1079/2017)

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.V.Sakthivel and the counsel for the first respondent Mr.C.Jawahar Ravindran, are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.



AWARD

The Insurance Company has filed the appeal, challenging the award passed in M.C.O.P.No.1742/2015 on the file of the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal/V Additional District Court, Madurai.

Both the parties along with their respective counsels are present. The claimants/respondents 1 to 3 are agreed to receive the amount of Rs.10,50,000/- as full quit. For which, the appellant/Insurance Company seeks time for depositing the remaining amount.

The appellant/Insurance Company is directed to deposit the award amount within a period of 12 weeks from the date of receipt of the award, less the amount already deposited, if any. The appellant/Insurance company is permitted to withdraw the excess amount, if any, with accrued interest. On such deposit being made, the first respondent/claimant is permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- and the claimants /respondents 2 and 3 are permitted to withdraw a sum of Rs.2,75,000/- each, by filing necessary application before the Tribunal.

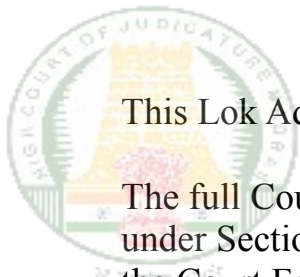
